Objectives

- To equip practitioners with tools that can be used to aid their communication with children
- To develop communication skills to better understand how to respond to children's emotional needs, particularly where there are safeguarding concerns
- To understand the barriers present in communicating with children
- To understand the barriers that may impinge on how professionals respond to what children tell them
