

MSCB Training Levels

Level 1

For paid and unpaid staff in regular contact with children, young people, adults, parents and carers (trusted adults).

Examples may include: leisure centre staff, fire fighters, reception staff, playscheme staff, housing officers, ambulance crews, elected members and lunchtime assistants. This training is a supplement to basic level CP training provided by agencies for their own staff.

Level 2

For paid and unpaid staff who work regularly with children, young people, parents and other adults who are carers and who may be required to contribute to assessments.

Examples may include: social workers, teachers, prison officers, probation officers, GPs, substance misuse workers, childminders, corporate parenting panel members, teachers and police officers.

Level 3

For paid and unpaid staff who have a particular responsibility for safeguarding children and/or are actively involved in undertaking s47 CP enquiries, assessment and intervention to safeguard children.

Examples may include: designated and named staff, social workers, CAIU police officers, LSCB members and Case conference chairs.
